### Mayor Nolen

- •Mayor Nolen recommended appointing Jeff Hatcher as the new city attorney. Councilmember Lindsey moved to appoint Mr. Hatcher as the new city attorney, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Hales. The vote was recorded to wit: Mayor Nolen yea, Councilmember Lindsey yea, Councilmember Burks yea, Councilmember Hales yea, Councilmember Fondren nay, and Councilmember Sorrells yea. Mayor Nolen declared the motion carried by majority vote. Mayor Nolen stated the City Judge and Magistrate will appoint the new defense attorney.
